## Academics

Dysart Schools are fully accredited and ready to serve the community with the very best academic options and innovative programs. 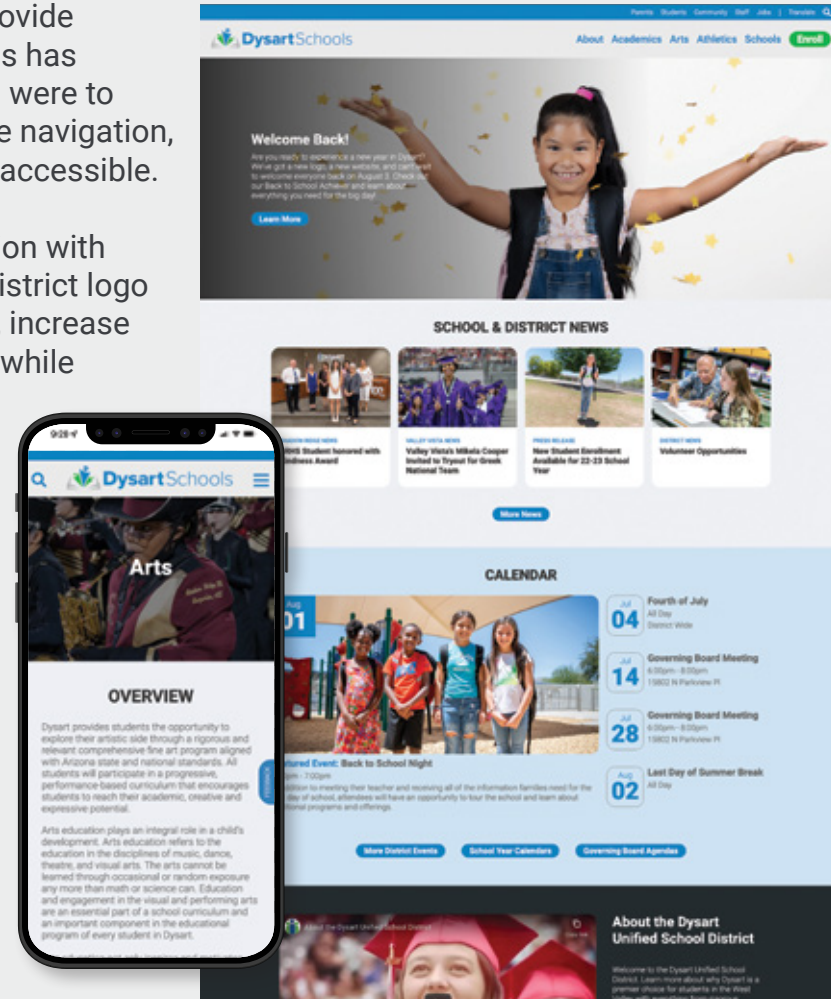

**DEVELOPMENTAL PRESCHOOL** provides special education services to students with an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) in an inclusive setting.

**PEER ROLE MODEL PRESCHOOL** is a program for typically developing children to serve an important role in the classroom alongside students with developmental disabilities. Tuition is charged at non-Title I schools.



## Is Your Preschooler's Development on Track?

If you are the parent of a preschool child or know of a preschool child with suspected developmental delays, residing within the boundaries of the Dysart Unified School District, you're eligible for a free Child Find screening. Suspected delays may be evidenced in the areas of communication, cognition, behavior, physical, auditory, visual and/or sensory development. Free screenings and/or diagnostic evaluations help determine those children eligible for special education services. 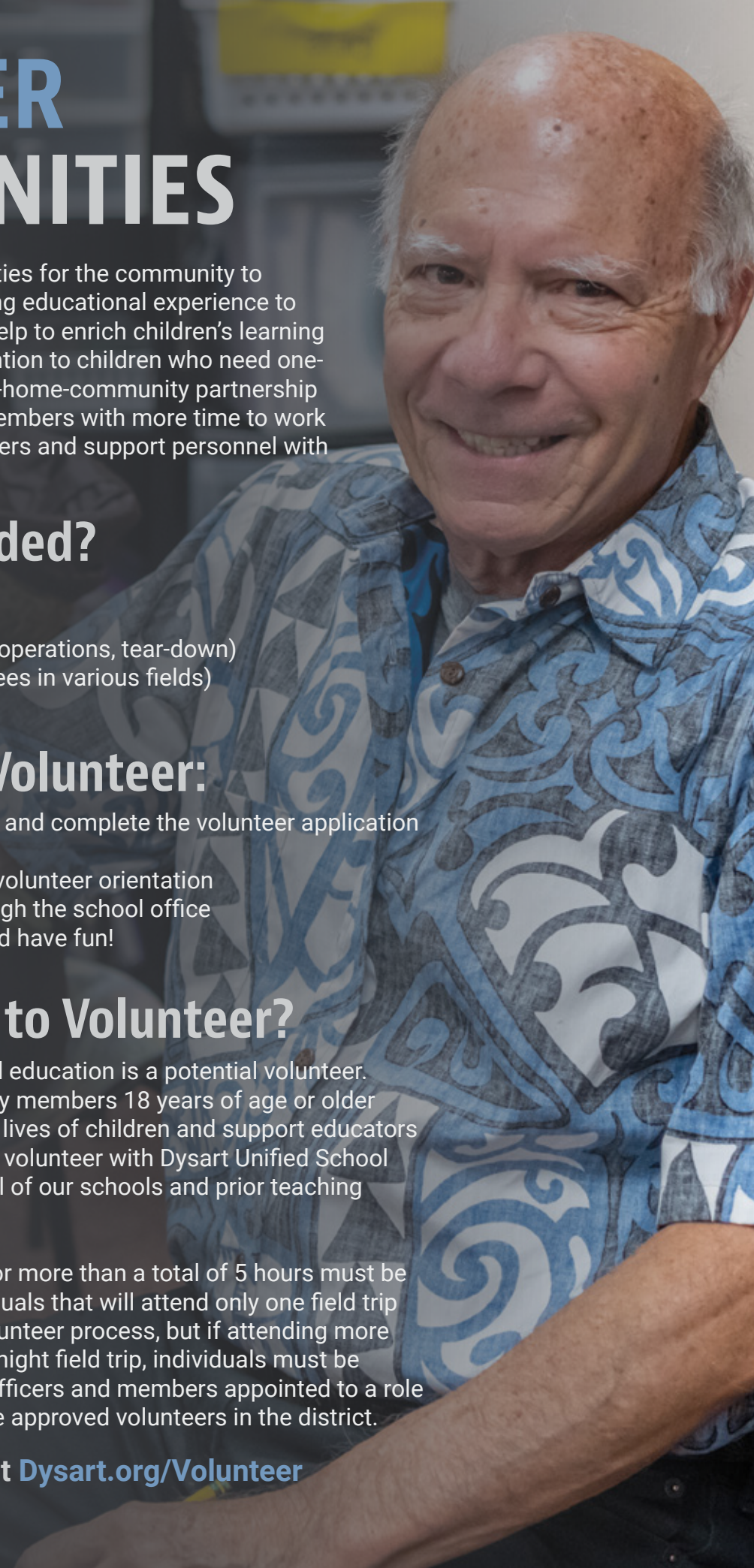

## Who Should Apply to Volunteer?

Anyone who cares about children and education is a potential volunteer. Parents, grandparents and community members 18 years of age or older who want to make a difference in the lives of children and support educators are encouraged to apply to become a volunteer with Dysart Unified School District. Volunteers are welcome in all of our schools and prior teaching experience is not necessary.

All individuals that are volunteering for more than a total of 5 hours must be an approved district volunteer. Individuals that will attend only one field trip per year do not need to follow the volunteer process, but if attending more than one field trip per year, or an overnight field trip, individuals must be fingerprinted. All Booster/PTO/PTA officers and members appointed to a role with financial responsibilities must be approved volunteers in the district.

# SCHOOL SAFETY

The safety and security of our students is our highest priority, and Dysart Schools have a comprehensive plan in place to support this important focus, which includes:

- Strong partnerships with local law enforcement and first responders, including School Resource Officers (SRO) at middle/high schools and a new district Safety Coordinator.
- Threat Assessment Teams on each campus to investigate potential threats to individuals or the campus, including reporting to law enforcement as needed.
- Planned practice drills and staff training throughout the year.
- School Safety Committees on each campus to discuss and plan facility safety, bullying, discipline, and emergency response procedures.
- Specific safety protocols in place for each type of emergency response: evacuation, lockdown, modified lockdown, shelter in place.
- Single point of entry for visitors, and required sign-in through the front office.
- Online Safe Report or Safe Schools hotline to report concerns to at [Dysart.org/SafeReport](https://Dysart.org/SafeReport) or 623-876-7009.

### K-4 AND K-8 ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

- K-8 students who are residents within a school attendance area and who live more than one radius mile from school. Please note this is not applicable to Freedom Traditional Academy, since it is an open enrollment school.

### MIDDLE SCHOOLS

- 5-8th grade students who are residents within the middle school boundaries and who live more than one and one-quarter radius miles from the school.

### HIGH SCHOOL

- Ninth through twelfth grade students who are residents within a school attendance area and who live more than one and one-half radius miles from school.

### SPECIAL EDUCATION

- Students with disabilities who require transportation, as indicated in their respective individual education programs.
