

## 2024-2025 Willow Canyon High School Integrated Action Plan Goals

<u>Mission</u>: At Willow Canyon High School, our mission is to create a transformative educational experience that cultivates a Winning Culture, fosters preparedness for each student's unique journey, and empowers them with the essential skills to succeed at the next stage of learning and beyond. <u>Vision</u>: Willow Canyon is Winning Culture!

<u>Goal</u>	Average growth from Aspire to ACT on composite score of 1.0 and/or above state average. AzSci proficiency rates will be above the state average and/or increase by 1% from prior year	85% of students, families and staff will rate their experience at Willow Canyon in a positive way, and/or increase by 10% (2023-24 positive rating of 87.12%).	Fully implement the Collaborative Team process, focusing on the use of common formative assessments (CFAs), data response strategies, and evidence-based improvements in student outcomes.
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## Action Steps

- Boundary students identified and engaged in collaborative study groups twice a week beginning in fall of 24'.
- Trailer math classes offered 7th period for credit retrieval and standard gap closure 1st and 2nd semesters.
- ACT prep materials administered both first and second semester & ACT bootcamp Jan. 13 - April 4, 2025
- Professional Development (PD): Collaborative Team and SPARK PD

- By September 2024 all classified staff will receive updated training in Willow Customer Service.
- Quarterly Dip Surveys will be administered, and feedback will be shared with Instructional Leadership and action plans for improvement will be created.
- By April of 2025, there will be a minimum of 6 Principal/ Student meetings where students have a voice in what is going well, and suggestions/ feedback is shared.
- Host community events (sports, arts, performances) weekly
- Personalized communication to freshman parents about their child's experience and progress.
- Teacher and parents communication strategies.

- Collaborative Team Training and Professional Development: By the end of each semester, conduct at least 4
   Collaborative Team training sessions for all teachers, achieving 90% attendance and a post-training satisfaction rating of at least 80%.
- Weekly Common Formative Assessments (CFAs): Throughout the academic year, develop and implement weekly CFAs in 100% of subject areas, with all teachers submitting their assessments on time and incorporating feedback from the evaluations.
- Weekly Collaborative Team Meetings:
   Schedule and conduct weekly
   Collaborative Team meetings throughout the academic year, achieving a 95% attendance rate and maintaining meeting minutes that document data analysis and instructional planning.
- Data Tracking and Instructional Strategy
  Review: Throughout the academic year,
  analyze assessment data and review
  instructional strategies at least bi-weekly,
  ensuring documented reviews and
  adjustments based on the data analysis.
- Data Collection Protocol: By the end of the first quarter, implement a standardized data collection protocol for all CFAs, achieving 100% adherence with

			data collected, analyzed, and reported according to established guidelines.  • Student Outcome Evidence: Conduct quarterly analyses of student performance data on CFAs and summative assessments throughout the academic year, aiming for at least a 10% increase in proficiency rates by the end of the year.
