Mission: Freedom Traditional Academy is committed to providing a well-rounded educational experience in which students develop great citizenship and achieve academic excellence through rigorous, accelerated, and purposeful curriculum while supported by an engaged and involved family community.

SMART Goals (Academic):

- By May of 2023, the number of 3rd-8th grade students at proficiency will be increased by 5% on grade-level
 math standards as measured by the state assessment.
- By May of 2023, the number of 3rd-8th grade students at proficiency will be increased by 5% on grade level
 ELA standards as measured by the state assessment.
- By May of 2023, 80% of 4th-8th grade students will increase at least one point value as measured by the state writing assessment rubric.
 - By May of 2023, the overall percent passing for fifth and eighth grade students will increase by 5% as measured on the AzSCI state assessment.

Strategies:

- PLC's will be used to collaborate about students vertically, at grade level, across contents, and with intervention teams
- Professional development on rigor, checks for understanding, and writing will be provided.
- Monthly CFA's will be administered and data will be used to drive Tier 2 instruction.
 - A positive culture of learning will be supported and areas of instructional need will be identified and problem solved.
 - Rtl will be utilized to respond to student needs.
