<u>ELA</u>

- Folder for grade level 3-ring Binder
- Loose-Leaf Lined Paper
- Pencils
- Colored Pencils
- 2 red pens, 2 blue pens, 2 green pens, 2 black pens OR a Bic 4-color ballpoint pen
- Highlighters
- Donations of tissues and disinfecting wipes welcomed

<u>Math</u>

- 2 Folders (one for grade level 3-ring Binder, and another for assignments)
- Loose-Leaf Lined Paper
- Pencils/Pens
- Expo Markers
- Calculator

<u>Science</u>

- 2 Folders (one for current modules of study content in grade level 3-ring Binder, and another for past modules of study content for final exam preparation)
- Loose-Leaf Lined Paper
- Pencils/Pens
- Expo Markers (2 different colors)
- Colored Pencils
- 2 red pens, 2 blue pens, 2 green pens, 2 black pens OR a Bic 4-color ballpoint pen
- Highlighter (color of choice)
- Calculator

Social Studies
