
All students who are interested in trying out for sports must register through Aktivate.

As we settle into the new school year the number one goal is always safety. Please remember during drop off and pick up you must be in the driveline, or on an adjacent street near a crosswalk not in the main flow of traffic. Dropping your student off in the roadway, on the side of the road in front of the school, or in the bike lane is dangerous and becomes a traffic hazard and is a traffic violation.

Please be mindful of your speed, students are regularly crossing the street and unfortunately have been hit in the past due to distracted driving and speed. The speed limit through the school zone before and after school is 15mph. Please help us ensure the safety of all students and staff by watching your speed.

As a reminder to all Ashton Ranch families, the Ashton Ranch Park just to the west of the school is a private park owned by the Ashton Ranch community HOA. Please ensure if you are dropping off your student early in the morning they are not at the park. Recently, gatherings at the park have increased causing students getting hurt and property being damaged. The Ashton Ranch HOA has advised they will trespass from the park due to increasing issues and liability.

HANDBOOK FOCUS OF THE WEEK: GOOD NEIGHBOR POLICY

Good Neighbor Policy School rules and other reasonable expectations for acceptable student behavior are extended to include student conduct while going to and from school and off campus during the normal school day. This includes a student's conduct during lunch hour or release periods. Inclusive in this is loitering and smoking on adjacent property of the school. Violations of conduct by students in this manner may result in disciplinary action. (Policy 5-305A, 5-306)

Students who trespass in this park can be held accountable to school rules. Please use the parent drop off/pick up instead of unsafe practices of picking up/dropping off at the park.
