Happy Friday Mustang families, we had another amazing week here at the Ranch! I wanted to ask for your partnership with a few things that have come to our attention over the past two weeks in reference to safety and community concerns.

Moving forward, please do not drop off, pick up, or park to wait for your student in the bike lane at the park on Parkview and Acoma. If you are parking or stopping in that location you are illegally parked and are a traffic hazard. If you park on a neighborhood side street, on the west side of Parkview with no bike lane, you are then legally parked and can wait for your student to cross the crosswalk safely. Due to recent incidents and community concerns, myself and our Motor Units will be monitoring the area for traffic issues which could result in a traffic violation with citation. Starting next week, please make arrangements to park, pick up, or drop off in our designated locations or where you are legally able to do so on a neighborhood side street with no bike lane.

In addition to parking, please make sure if your student rides a bike or scooter to school they are walking them across the crosswalks and in front of the school. We have had multiple students fall off bikes in the roadway while riding across crosswalks and nearly hit other students or staff walking to the front office. Failure to walk your bike or scooter across the crosswalk, or in front of the school after being asked to do so by staff may result in student discipline.

I want to thank everyone for all your help and support keeping our students and campus safe. It was a great week of growth here at The Ranch!
