


Goal 1

By May of 2024, 3rd-8th Grade students will increase proficiency scores on grade level standards for both ELA and Math by at least 3% as measured by the state assessment and Kindergarten-3rd Grade students will increase percent of students at or above benchmark by at least 5% as measured by the Composite DIBELS Acadience Assessment.

Our Kindergarten - 3rd Grade students took the Beginning of the Year DIBELS Assessment. 57% of our students are at or above benchmark. Our goal for the End of the Year DIBELS Assessment is to have 62% of our students at or above benchmark.

Parent/Teacher Conferences will be the week of October 2nd, be on the lookout for sign ups later this month so you can partner with your child's teachers to work together!




Goal 2

By May of 2024, the number of students receiving referrals will decrease from 25% to 20%.

Goal 3

By May of 2024, staff and parent satisfaction as reported by "I would recommend Luke" will remain at 85% or increase.
