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Math & ELA Proficiency Goal: Students in 3rd-8th grade will score at least 40% on grade level math and ELA standards as measured by the State assessment.

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Math & Goal Reduction of Minimally Proficient Goal: Students in 3rd-8th grade will decrease the minimally proficient cohort group by 10% on grade level Math standards as measured by the State assessment.

Math & ELA Sub-Population (EL & ESS) Goal: ESS and EL students will show an overall increase of 10% in proficiency as measured by the State assessment in both math and English.

Culture and Climate Goal: The Thompson Ranch Community (students, staff, and families) will decrease the overall school referrals by 30% as measured by the previous year, **AND** 70% of staff and parents will respond that they would recommend Thompson Ranch to a family who is looking for a school.
