PRINCIPAL'S LETTER

Dear Sunset Hills Families.

We have had an outstanding first month of school at Sunset Hills! We are so excited to welcome all staff, students and families back for our 2022-2023 school year. I want to share my appreciation for all of the staff and teachers for planning extraordinary learning experiences that engage students throughout each and every day!

As part of the continuous improvement process at Sunset Hills, we have school-wide goals that we will all be working together to meet throughout the school year. These goals are as follows:

- 1.By May of 2023, a minimum of 62% of students in grades 3-8 will achieve proficiency in Math, a minimum of 68% of students in grades 3-8 will achieve proficiency in ELA, and minimally proficient will be reduced by 10% as measured by AASA. Additionally, a minimum of 70% of students in grades 5 and 8 will achieve proficiency in Science as measured by AzSci State Assessment.
- 2. By May of 2023, 100% of staff will implement PBIS with fidelity for all students as evidenced by weekly lessons, reinforcement system data, and tracking within the accountability system. As a result of PBIS implementation referrals for defiance and disrespect and physical aggression will be reduced by 10%.
- 3. By May of 2023, a minimum of 22% of EL and ESS students will show proficiency as measured by AASA in ELA and Math.

Our outstanding teachers have begun the school year with a focus on cultivating a positive classroom culture that fosters academic growth for all students. They have used our school-wide goals to write grade level goals for their students. Teachers work collaboratively with their grade level teams and other staff through a continuous improvement process that includes articulating what students are to learn, planning how students will show mastery, and engaging in cycles of assessment and reflection on how their own teaching practices impact student learning. From there, they plan targeted, small group instruction for their students. We are excited to see the tremendous growth in all of our students!

Thank you to all of our families for your continued partnership. We look forward to working with you on our journey! Together, we will continue to be successful!

Digital Communications
