We are so proud to announce that Sunset Hills is an "A" rated school! Another celebration is that Sunset Hills is ranked in the top 100 schools in the entire state of Arizona! I am so proud of all of our efforts as an entire school community! We will be holding a barbeque celebration with Kona Ice at lunch on December 7, to celebrate with our students!

We continue to work each day to meet the individual needs of all of our students. We are gearing up for assessments for students in K-8. DIBELS testing for grades kindergarten through 4th grade will be the week of December 5-9. Grades 3-5 will have math and reading benchmarks the week of December 5. Final exams for grades 6-8 will occur between December 12-20, with the multiple choice section of the final exam scheduled on December 16th, 19th and 20th. Benchmarks for grades 6-8 will be the week of January 9-13. The data from these assessments will be used to calculate growth from Benchmark 1 to Benchmark 2 and to review and revise student goals. Please encourage your child to do their best! We are excited to see the growth in each of our students!

This is a great time of year to bring home Sunset Hills' Arts Signature Program. No, you don't have to be a musician, actor, or painter! 'Tis the season for storytelling, quite possibly the world's oldest art form. There are so many popular stories circulating this time of year, and the 'cool' part is, you don't even need a book. Storytelling is the art of "using language and gesture in colorful ways to create scenes in a sequence" (Gere, Kozlovich, & Kelin, 2002). Unlike reading from a book, each story being told is unique, and reflects the personality of the storyteller. Stories impact emotions and perspectives; through inflection and gestures in narrative, a storyteller activates imagination and visualization in each listener, which are important literacy tools. Reading a story from a book does reinforce literacy, but is unchanging. A storyteller is dynamic, constantly evaluating the reactions and nonverbal signals from their audience; if something makes the listener laugh, a storyteller may decide to use similar cues as the story continues. If the storyteller senses a loss of interest from the audience, they may increase the energy and intensity with which they deliver their performance. Research shows that storytelling encourages active listening, builds analytical skills, and increases memory and comprehension. (Donovan & Pascale, 2004) So, take some time this season to share holiday stories from your past or give context to family holiday traditions. You'll not only connect with your kids in a fun way, but promote artistic thinking in your home.
