### Handbook Focus of the Week

#### Noble Character - The N. in W.I.N.

According to Dysart Schools handbook and in alignment with Arizona State law (ARS 15-841), students have the protected right to learn without others' interference. Arizona Revised Statute (A.R.S.) § 15-841 outlines the responsibilities of students and gives school districts the authority to discipline, suspend, and expel pupils. The law also details the process for handling disciplinary actions, including requirements for alternative education programs and placement review committees. Students who consistently disrupt the learning process in the classroom can be removed from the class and placed in alternative learning environments. Continued behaviors can lead to escalated consequences.

At Willow Canyon, the N. in W.I.N. stands for nobility of character. It is not just a rule but is inherent in our Winning Culture values.
