Handbook Focus of the Week

Due Process Announcements

We will be providing due process announcements at the beginning of next semester to remind students of our campus rules and expectations. Here is a sneak preview.

1. Bathroom reminders: there is only to be one Wildcat in a stall at a time. Violations will result in an automatic off-campus suspension.
2. WCHS is a closed campus. Students must remain on campus during the day unless called out by parent/guardian and they check out in the front office.
3. Parking lot reminders: all students must have a parking pass and park only in their designated spot. Violations and improper conduct can result in revocation of parking pass.
4. Tardies - we need you here on time each and every day. Progressive consequences can occur for being late.
5. Chronic absenteeism can result in loss of learning and can also result in loss of credit leading to needing to retake a class and possible delay of graduation. State law mandates students are present 90% of the time which equals no more than 10 absences per semester.
6. Dress code is still in effect each and every day. Please consult the handbook for dress code guidelines.
7. Keeping Willow clean takes all of us. Please pick up after yourself at lunch, in the classroom and around campus.
8. Winning Culture isn't just for athletes or competitors - it is for all Wildcats. When attending events please remember W.I.N.ning values and treat all with respect.
