

PARKING DATES TO REMEMBER 2023-2024

The following are the dates for all parking-related items for the school year 2023-2024. All applications will require a Valid Arizona Driver's License (no permits), current insurance for vehicle, and registration. Parking will be established by a first-come, first-serve basis on dates listed below. **Parking spaces will be available for eligible seniors, juniors, or sophomores.** All applicants must be on track with credits to meet their 2023-2024 cohort requirements <u>prior</u> to applying for a permit. Students will be assigned specific parking spots for the 2023-2024 school year.

<u>Student Automobile Use and Parking</u>: Refer to DUSD Student and Parent Handbook and Dysart Board Policy 10.59.

Parking Passes may be purchased in the bookstore from 7-10 am. Please see the table below for the priority purchase schedule.

Please Note:

- Any outstanding debts in the bookstore, MUST be paid prior to receiving a parking permit. <u>All debts must be cleared before being eligible for a parking spot.</u>
- Payments can be made at the bookstore via cash, check or credit card.
- Completed applications must be submitted prior to going to the bookstore for payment.
- Parking is only allowed in your designated spot.

In addition to a complete application and \$60 payment you must present valid proof of the following:

Valid Arizona <u>Graduated</u> Driver's License

Current Arizona Vehicle Registration (for all vehicles listed)

Current Proof of Insurance, valid for at least 3 months (for all vehicles listed)

** Your packet will not be complete without all three (3) items. ** ** Incomplete packets will not be accepted. **


All information must be provided for this to be considered a complete application.

STUDENT PARKING REGULATIONS

- 1. Students will be assigned a numbered parking space that corresponds to their parking permit number.
- 2. Parking Permits **must be properly displayed** in the vehicle it was assigned. Displaying a permit in a vehicle other than the one assigned to that space may result in suspension or revocation of parking privileges.
- 3. If a vehicle is parked in your assigned space please see security before parking your vehicle.
- 4. Parking in a non-student parking space will result in being booted.
- 5. A student may **not give, sell, trade or loan** his/her assigned parking space/Parking Permit to another student, including siblings. This will result in the **revocation** of both students' parking privileges.
- 6. When an alternate vehicle not on file is driven to school, the student must notify Security. Failure to do so may result in suspension of parking privileges.
- 7. There is a \$5.00 replacement fee for a mutilated parking tag, which must be turned into the Bookstore Manager when purchasing a replacement. There will be no replacement for the lost parking tag unless a police report has been filed on the stolen vehicle. You will have to purchase a new parking pass for a lost pass.
- 8. Student parking lot hours are between 6:30 am and 2:30 pm. No loitering in the parking lots, in or out of the vehicle.
- 9. Unsafe driving practices on school property will result in suspension of your parking privileges.
- 10. Students must follow proper sign-out procedures when leaving early. You will need to be signed out by a Parent/Guardian at the front office prior to exiting the lot. (This excludes seniors who have early release.)
- 11. Students must obtain permission from the Administration **before** going to their vehicle during school operating hours.
- 12. **No derogatory stickers, drawings, or writing** are allowed to be displayed on vehicles Ex: 187, 602, silhouettes of naked women, symbols of alcohol products, drugs, weapons, obscene language, etc.
- 13. Searches of vehicles will take place whenever a school official has **reasonable suspicion** to believe that illegal items, illegal drugs, alcohol, weapons or unauthorized persons, etc., are contained within the vehicle.
- 14. All accidents in the parking lot must be reported **immediately** to security and an incident report must be filed.
- 15. **Park at Your Own Risk.** Valley Vista High School and/or its personnel are not responsible for personal property, theft, loss or damage to vehicles and property.
- 16. If parking privileges are revoked, no refund will be issued.
- 17. Students are not allowed to park in Carpool Spaces
- 18. If a handicap is needed, please provide documentation to the nurse.

In the event that any of the above-mentioned guidelines are not followed, your vehicle may be towed away at your expense. Furthermore, upon a determination by security or administration, your parking privileges may be revoked.

PARKING VIOLATION PROCEDURES:

All students are required to park in the student parking lot only, which is located off of Tierra Buena north of campus.

REASONS A VEHICLE MAY BE BOOTED:

- 1. If the vehicle is parked in any reserved student or staff parking space and has no visible parking permit.
- 2. If the vehicle has a visible student parking permit but is parked in a **staff**, **visitor**, **maintenance**, **bus or any other non-student parking space**.
- 3. If the vehicle has been observed being driven in a reckless or unsafe manner, speeding, or otherwise not obeying the traffic and safety rules.


BOOTING PROCEDURES:


- 1. First violation: vehicle may have a parking boot placed on the driver side front wheel and a "booted" warning sticker placed on the driver side window. Students will report to the Administration in the discipline office to have the boot removed by security or maintenance. Students will have a fine of \$60 placed on their account. Disciplinary action may be assigned for insubordination.
- 2. All other violations: vehicle may be towed by a towing company at the owner's risk and expense. Students will then be disciplined for insubordination and may receive additional disciplinary action.

REASONS A STUDENT MAY LOSE PARKING PRIVILEGES:

- 1. Failure to abide by the parking procedures as outlined above
- 2. Driving recklessly or in an unsafe manner; excessive speed
- 3. Excessive absences or tardy-abuse of the VVHS attendance policy
- 4. Repeated disciplinary incidences
- 5. Academic failure

In the event that any of the above-mentioned guidelines are not followed, your vehicle may be towed away at your expense. Furthermore, upon a determination by security or administration, your parking privileges may be revoked.
